The first Chamber of Commerce in the area was formed in 1936 in the town of Grand Coulee. Two years later, a Chamber of Commerce was also formed in Coulee Dam. The two institutions worked and met independently, but did coordinated community events until 1977. At that time, it was overwhelmingly voted by chamber members to combine the two Chambers into one, and the current Grand Coulee Dam Area Chamber of Commerce was born.
